

*Tompkins Township
Minutes
June 7, 2005*

Prior to the Regular Meeting the Tompkins Township Board met at the Stewart Property at 6:30 p.m. to assess the condition of the barns. The Board and several residents of the township walked around the barns. Followed by the regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board being called to order at 7:30p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John Tuttle. Members present in addition to the supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, Treasurer Linda Sterrett, Trustee Gary Purcell and Trustee Nancy Seydell. The minutes of the May 4, 2005 regular board meeting were approved following a motion by Seydell, supported by Purcell. MOTION - John Tuttle to call attorney as necessary by Seydell, supported by Tuttle. Amended to read: after consultation of MTA attorney. Moved by Sterrett, support by Purcell. Amendment voice vote. Motion carried. Motion voice vote. Motion carried.

MOTION - Bob Flack to represent Tompkins Township for the conditional use permit as landlords moved by Sterrett, support by Tuttle. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

MOTION- Mechanical Permits from \$45.00 to \$60.00 per inspection, plus \$10.00 base fee effective June 8th, moved by Sterrett, support by Purcell. Roll call yes votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 9:10 p.m. with no comments.

The supervisor read the two building permits, and the meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m. with ten in attendance.
