The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 5:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John Tuttle followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. Moved by Sterrett, seconded by Curran to change meeting date of the regular Township Board Meeting from August 2 to August 4, 5:00 p.m. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.
