Minutes

March 2, 2010

The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John Tuttle followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. Members present in addition to the Supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, Treasurer Linda Sterrett, Trustee Nancy Seydell, and Trustee Mike Haydo. The minutes of the **February 2, 2010 Board meeting** was approved following a motion by Sterrett, seconded by Seydell. **Vouchers for the fire department** bills were read. Moved to accept the vouchers by Curran, seconded by Sterrett. Motion carried. **Treasurer's report** was read as: Disbursements of \$25,830.58, deposits of \$35,075.45, and a balance of \$190,238.44. The report was approved following a motion by Seydell, seconded by Curran. **Prepay** Moved to prepay Champion Printing 294.81 for assessment notices by Sterrett, seconded by Seydell. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 6:30 p.m. No comments were received and the meeting continued.

Building Permits Moved by Sterrett, seconded by Curran to increase **Electrical Permits** for Houses from \$1.00 per thousand to \$2.50 per thousand. Double Wides, Mobile Homes, and Modulars stay the same. Additions and Updates, Garages, Pole Barns from \$100.00 to \$130.00. Remove minimum fee of \$100.00. Effective March 3, 2010. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Repair to Township Hall - Damage to the township hall eaves area. Waiting on adjuster, quotes for repairs in process. Move to approve repair to the townhall maximum of \$2850.00 by Tuttle, seconded by Sterrett. Could be hidden damage, only preliminary quote, and may be different actual. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

MTA Conference - Contracts 101 for a cost of \$85.00 to send John Tuttle plus expenses by Seydell, seconded by Sterrett. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Capital Conference - April 21, 2010, for a cost of \$75.00 plus expenses, to send John Tuttle, and Melanie Curran, by Seydell, seconded by Sterrett. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Maintenance to Township Hall - Moved by Seydell, seconded by Sterrett to hire John Tuttle and Mike Haydo as maintenance providers for the township hall at a rate of \$10.00 per hour. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Prepay MTA Conferences - Registration for conferences approved for prepay as necessary for the conferences approved. Moved by Curran, seconded by Sterrett. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 8:10 p.m. with no comments received and the meeting continued.

No building permits were issued this month.

The meeting was adjourned at approx. 8:12 p.m. with four in attendance.
