The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John A. Pay all the bills and approve the post-audit bills as reported, moved by Baldwin, seconded by Haydo. Roll call yes votes: Seydell, Curran, Haydo, and Baldwin, and Tuttle. No votes: none. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 7:17 p.m. Comments were received and the meeting continued.

Public Hearing was opened to hear Dangerous Building Hearing regarding property at 5713 Grand River Rd., Randy Hulbert. Dangerous Building Hearing held on August 21, 2020 gave Mr. Hulbert a deadline to remove a burned out mobile home, and nothing has been done yet. After discussion, moved by Tuttle, seconded by Seydell to give Mr. Hulbert until November 20, 2020 to have the trailer and the contents removed or the township will start proceedings to do it, and have the costs put on the tax bill. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried. Hearing was closed.

Moved by Baldwin, seconded by Curran to prepay Bryan Powers, Dangerous Buildings Officer \$50.00 for this meeting. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Region 2 membership was declined for this year. No interest to move for membership.

Jackson County Interlocal Agreement for County Designated Assessor – Resolution: Moved to authorize the Supervisor, John A. Tuttle, Sr. to sign the agreement to authorize Ruth Scott to be the county designated assessor per the Agreement, seconded by Curran. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Election Wages- Moved by Curran, seconded by Seydell to preapprove and prepay election wages (\$1913.50). Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Public Comment was opened at 8:04p.m. No additional comments were received and the meeting continued.

Seven permits were issued this month for building activity.

The meeting was adjourned approximately 8:10 p.m. with nine in attendance.
