To the qualified Electors of the City and all Townships in the County of Jackson, State of Michigan: notice is hereby given that a Primary Election will be held for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following: U.S. Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, County Commission and any local vacancies as required by law. In addition to above offices, Precinct Delegates will also be elected.

The further purpose of the Election is to vote on the proposals as presented and listed below:

CITY OF JACKSON PROPOSAL **MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN THE CITY OF JACKSON**

The Jackson Area Transportation Authority (JATA) is encouraging all city registered voters to vote on August 2nd. JATA will be requesting a one mill transit renewal. The renewal is not a new tax. The renewal simply allows JATA to continue to operate at its' current level. Without local support, JATA would have to drastically reduce services.

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BLACKMAN PROPOSAL **ROD MILLS PARK MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the authorized charter millage for the Charter Township of Blackman, established for years 2017 through 2021 inclusive at .25 mills (\$.25 Per \$1,000 of taxable value) and reduced to .2493 mills (\$.2493 per \$1, 000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be increased, back to the original millage of .25 mills (\$.25 per \$1,000 taxable value) for Five (5) years, 2022 through 2026 inclusive, for the maintenance, improvements, enhancements, and additions to the Township park system, which .25-mills will raise an estimated \$139,495 in the first year the millage is levied.

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SANDSTONE **RENEWAL OF MILLAGE FOR POLICE PROTECTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation, imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in the Charter Township of Sandstone of 0.5 mill (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.4994 mills (\$.4994 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, which is set to expire on December 31, 2022, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 0.50 mill (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for five (5) years, 2023 through 2027 inclusive, to be used to provide police protection and public safety services for the residents of Sandstone Charter Township, whether by contracting for such services or establishing a police department. This millage will raise an estimated Seventy Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$76,400) in the first year the millage is levied.

SPRINGPORT TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

SPRINGPORT TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the 15-mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Springport Township imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution be renewed for said Township, Jackson County, Michigan, by 1.5 mills, (\$1.50 per \$1,000.00 for taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2022 through 2026 inclusive, for fire and rescue operations; and shall the Township levy such renewal in the millage for such purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$106,800.00?
