

# Tompkins Township Land and Property Use Rules

These rules are presented as a Policy for use of Tompkins Township land.

It is your responsibility as a user of Township property to be informed of these rules and abide by them.

The following is not allowed on township property

1. No alcoholic beverages allowed on Township property.
2. Disposal or dumping of trash, rubbish, or garbage unless authorized to do so in authorized containers
3. Burning or burying of trash, rubbish, or garbage.
4. Build a fire unless in a preapproved designated area. This is subject to weather conditions.
5. Engage in violent, abusive, loud, vulgar, lewd, or otherwise disorderly conduct.
6. Erect a fence or barrier or set up in a road or lane so as to block the progress of another person.
7. Damage, remove or destroy any natural flora, fauna, or property that is on township property
8. Post a sign or solicitation of any kind unless approved by Township Supervisor in writing in advance of activity
9. Hold an event open to the public including but not limited to a race, endurance contest, tournament, or trail ride, unless that event has been approved by the township board prior to the event.
10. Use of a loud speaker or public address system or any kind of sound amplifying equipment without prior approval.
11. Erect or install lighting that will extend beyond the boundary of the township property or that will affect the use of township property by another person.
12. Store or leave for an extended period of time (7days) any motorized vehicle or other type of structure.
13. Use township property for commercial operations
14. Target shoot at any object unless it is part of an event approved by the Township Board.
15. Camp or spend the night unless approved as a part of an organized event. ( See Township Campground Rules)
16. Allow a dog or any other animal to roam or graze freely. Dogs must be on a lease no longer than 10 ft.
17. Use or ignite fireworks or any other device that either leaves the ground or cause sparks or fire unless properly permitted and authorized to do so by the Township Board.
18. If you plan on operating a 4 wheeler or ORV, you must provide proof of insurance and obtain a permit for its use.
19. No hunting or trapping, except nuisance trapping approved by the Township Board.
20. No unauthorized Vehicles outside of the designated parking area.

This policy is in effect as of 7/7/2016
